> Thank you for providing these additional details regarding the project, and for your patience as we have taken time to review them.

>

> If I understand correctly, you are proposing that the international sponsor (RC Los Alamos) will manage the grant funds. Is this understanding correct? This would be an acceptable route to go for funding. If you confirm, I will send the bank information listed on the application back into draft status so that you may update the details accordingly.

Yes, that is correct. I have asked Alison Pannel to send me the banking details for RC Los Alamos.

> The other information that you have provided is sufficient for us to moved forward with approving the grant application. Once the bank information has been updated appropriately, we can move forward with an approval.

We would like to change some of the details of the application. In particular, we would like to

-Adjust the start and end date of the grant

-Adjust the budget, because Atisa Securities informed us that they must reallocate their 2022 allocation for us given that SARS has not yet provided us with a Section 18a (tax exemption) certificate. The email from Atisa Director Peter Myers additionally states: "I assure you that we will look favourably on any application you may make for an allocation out of our 2023 budget which we will start considering in early 2023." However, we do not want to rely on this donation and in particular on when in 2023 the money would arrive. Therefore, it would seem more prudent not to include this gift in the GG.

What would the procedure be for making these adjustments? Can we send you a memo with revised dates and a revised budget?
